Camper Information

Camp Re-NEW-All is for Catholic young people in the diocese, or those interested in the faith, who are going into the 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, or 9th grade. Campers who are entering 9th grade may be asked to assist staff with some activities, but are considered campers.

Preference for attendance is given to youth from the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau. Complete the application and medical form as soon as possible. A parent or guardian must sign the medical form included with the application. Acceptance letters are mailed after the 2nd week of April. Included with the acceptance letter are a needs list and map to the camp. All campers must provide their own transportation. Carpooling is encouraged.

NOTE:

- Priority is given to those campers who applied last year before the application deadline and could not be placed.
- ♦ Cancellations must be received at least 10 business days prior to session to be eligible for a refund.
- No Camper substitutes will be allowed.
- Campers and staff will receive an acceptance letter, indicating their eligibility to attend.
- ♦ Staff arrives on Sunday. Campers arrive on Monday.

<u>Deadline for Camper Application is</u> March 15, 2017.

Staff Information

There are three categories of Staff: *Adult Staff* (age 21 and over); *Young Adult Staff* (18-20 years old during your session at camp); *High School Staff* (10th, 11th, 12th under 18 years old).

Priests, religious, seminarians, lay men and women, Catholic college and high school students from the diocese and beyond volunteer their services in the following areas:

Each Session needs 35 to 50 staff members, depending on the camp site. Notification of staff assignments will be mailed after the 2nd week of April. All adult and young adult staff must attend a Virtus Safe Environment Class, complete the diocesan background screening, and read and sign the Diocesan Code of Conduct.
